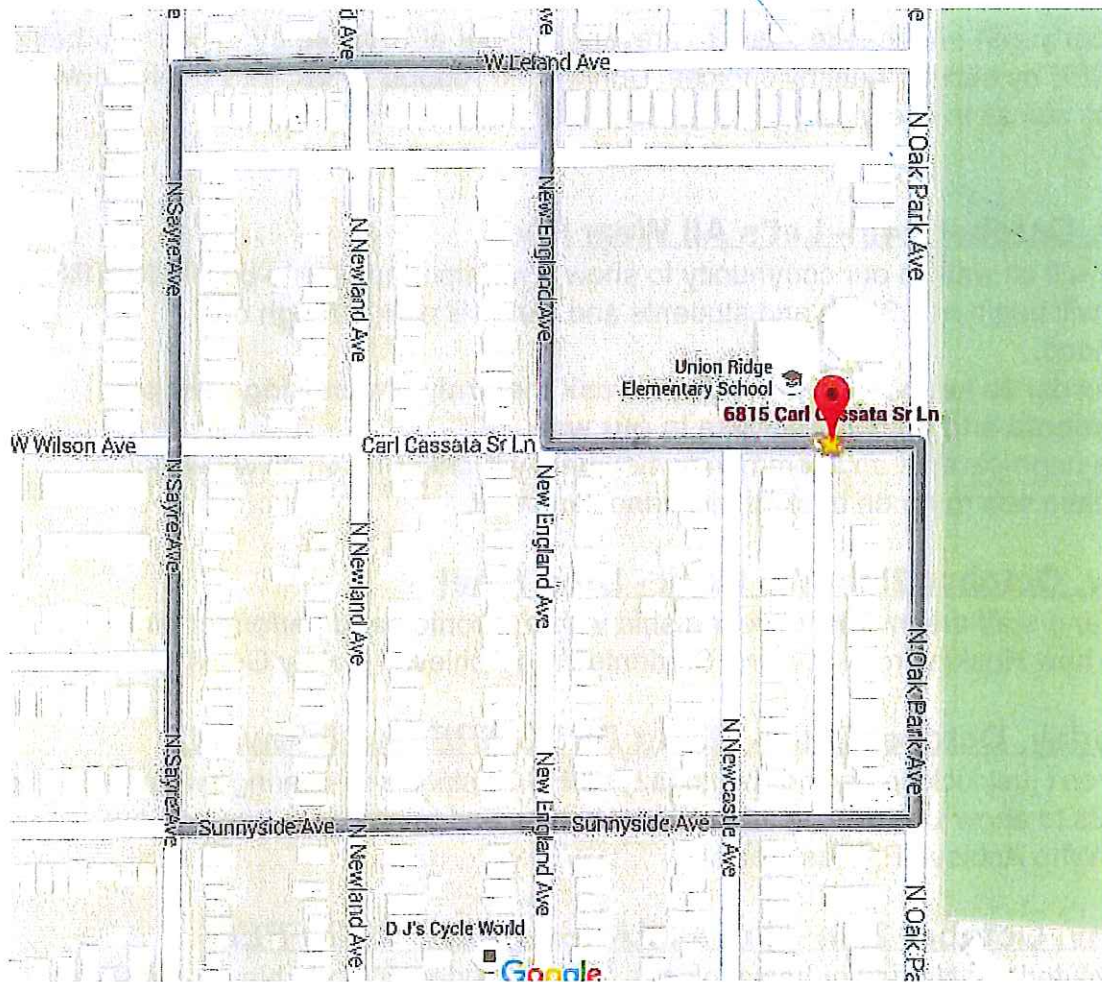
Thursday, October 27th - I'm a JEAN-ius, I'm DRUG FREE!

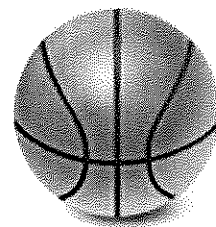
